Dear Parents,

You will have noticed that we are extremely busy around the Nursery front door, and also the office area at certain times of the day. We are full to capacity and I would wish to take this opportunity to share our appreciation to those among our parents and their friends for their recommendations; which bring new children to our nursery regularly. Thank you, your support is greatly appreciated.

If you wish to speak with us – please telephone away from busy lunchtimes or else ask for an appointment with a member of our team. We are very happy to help anyone – once the rush has eased off.

Many times we come to understand that any difficulties at nursery are often linked to similar difficulties at home. Please do talk to a member of our staff — especially anyone on our Senior Staff. We are willing to listen and talk through such situations and we do have direct access to local family workers who are trained and skilled in helping with many of the problems young parents' experience caring and teaching their children. Please ask; we would be very happy to help you.

As you will know, there has been a change in arrangements when celebrating birthdays. We greatly appreciate the willingness of parents to accept these changes. You will remember we are switching to Family Food First – this alters our children's menus, their supervision by our staff at lunch and snack times, as well as increasing the levels of physical exercise required during play.

To help us even more – please no last minute sweets or crisps as your children enter the Nursery. They will all come in and have fun without sweets being necessary. (The wrappers from these 'treats' also become a litter problem at our front door) Thank you.

Several children are learning how to use sign language at nursery -

Lift off to Language is a programme which is particularly useful and helpful where English is a second language or children may be reluctant to speak – perhaps they are shy. I do ask you please to help by practicing with them at home. If you also require help – again, please ask at Nursery.
