The Staff at Training Depot Day Nursery have noticed a few children travelling in vehicles to and from Nursery without the appropriate car seat/restraint. The safest way for children to travel in cars is in a child seat that is suitable for their weight and size. Even in a minor crash, an unrestrained child would be thrown about inside the vehicle, injuring themselves and others. They could even be thrown from the car through one of the windows. Please do not put us in the position of stopping you driving your child away for their own safety.

Thank you for choosing Training Depot Day Nursery.


