Sickness

Parents will be called to collect their children if:

- They have diarrhoea three times when at Nursery
- The child has been sick and has a high temperature, or
- The child has been sick twice at Nursery.

There is a minimum exclusion period of 48 hours for any child who has had a stomach upset, sickness or diarrhoea – either at nursery or at home.


Highlights of this month's latest news and reminders have to be –
